Mark: Hey, did I tell you that I bought a house in the suburbs of Tokyo?

Anthony: No, you didn't. Congratulations! But I've heard it's pretty expensive to buy one in Japan.

Mark: Yeah, it can be. Actually, my monthly payments are more affordable than they were when I was renting my old apartment. My children are growing up too and need more space, so buying a larger place made sense for us as a family.

Anthony: I see. Is the *1 real estate market in Japan a lot different from other countries?

Mark: Well, unlike most other countries, the value of a house here tends to decrease in value after it's bought, and as for the land itself, the value has been going down constantly since the 1990s. Houses are also not built to last here like in other countries, so they are often rebuilt during the owner's lifetime.

Anthony: That doesn't sound too promising at all. Why did you still decide to buy one?

Mark: To be honest, I had some bad experiences with renting here. Some landlords don't want to rent to foreign residents and there were so many fees to pay that made it expensive. In the end, owning a house has made us feel more settled and less likely to leave.

Anthony: That makes sense. So, you must still like living in Japan, I guess.

Mark: Generally, I do. Tokyo is, for the most part, a safe and clean city and there is less street crime here compared to other cities like London or New York, I think. Our kids can take public transportation across the city on their own and we don't have to worry at all.

Anthony: That's so true. But still, you must have some problems with the language barrier.

Mark: It used to be a challenge, especially when I first got here. For a while, I could get by with basic Japanese, but I made a real effort to learn the language and understand the culture. Plus, I've always found that Japanese people will often go out of their way to help foreigners in need.

Anthony: Well, it sounds like you really thought a lot about your decision. I imagine that many non-Japanese staying here long-term might consider the same issues.
